Coastal Plains High School's fundamental purpose is the pursuit of knowledge. Essential to the success of this mission is the commitment to the principles of academic integrity. All faculty and staff are responsible for upholding the highest standards of honesty at all times. Students are also responsible for adhering to the following Student Honor Code:

- Academic Honesty is demonstrated by students when the ideas and the writings of others are properly cited; students submit their own work for tests and assignments without unauthorized assistance; and students do not provide unauthorized assistance to others.
- **Respect** for others and the learning process to demonstrate academic honesty.
- **Responsibility** is recognized by all to demonstrate their best effort to prepare and complete academic tasks.
- Integrity of all students as demonstrated by a commitment to academic honesty.

Academic Dishonesty Definitions

Activities that have the effect or intention of interfering with education or the pursuit of knowledge are prohibited. Examples of such activities include but are not limited to:

- **Cheating:** using or attempting to use unauthorized assistance, materials, or study aids for exams or other academic work. *Example: using a cheat sheet on a quiz, test or exam to earn a better grade, etc.*
- **Plagiarism:** using the ideas, data, and language of another person without proper acknowledgement. *Example: copying another person's paper, article, or computer work and submitting it for an assignment, cloning someone else's ideas without attribution, etc.*
- **Fabrication:** submitting contrived or altered information in any assignment. *Example: making up data for an experiment, fudging data, citing nonexistent articles, etc.*
